Entry Requirement

In order to ensure the quality and integrity of the programme, applicants for the MBA (Supply Chain & Logistics) at the National Defence University of Malaysia (NDUM) must fulfil the following entry requirements:

- A Bachelor's Degree with a minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 2.50 in any field from any institution of higher learning recognised by the Government of Malaysia. Candidates with a CGPA lower than 2.50 must have a minimum 5 years of professional experience; or
- Diploma in any field from any institution of higher learning recognised by the Government of Malaysia with IO years of professional experience. Candidates will have to passed the Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APEL) test conducted by Malaysian Qualification Agency (MDA); or
- Other qualifications equivalent to Bachelor's Degree and experience in a related field (business, management, logistics, supply chain, economics or commerce) recognised by the NDUM Senate.
- Evidence of Bahasa Melayu and English Language proficiency in addition to academic credential; and
- A reference letter from the previous or current employer.

All shortlisted candidates will be notified through email and letter from the University. The candidates should also meet other requirements deemed necessary by the University before an offer is made for the programme.

- Transcript(s) and other relevant certificate(s)
- IC/Passport size photograph (one)
- Reference letter from previous or current employer or any documentation as proof of working experience.
- Language requirement (applies to Non-Native English speakers only):
 - IELTS (a minimum score of band 6.0); or
 - TOEFL (a minimum score of 550); or
 - Any other language proficiency test recognised by the University.
