Mode of Study

Entry Requirement

In order to ensure the quality and integrity of the programme, applicants for the MBM (Defence & Security) at the National Defence University of Malaysia (NDUM) must fulfil the following entry requirements:

- ❖ A Bachelor's Degree with a minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 2.50 in any field from any institution of higher learning recognised by the Government of Malaysia. Candidates with a CGPA lower than 2.50 must have a minimum 5 years of professional experience; or
- ❖ Diploma in any field from any institution of higher learning recognised by the Government of Malaysia with 10 years of professional experience. Candidates will have to passed the *Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APEL)* test conducted by Malaysian Qualification Agency (MQA); or
- ❖ Other qualifications equivalent to Bachelor's Degree and experience in a related field (business, management,
