Entry Requirement

- i. A bachelor's degree with a minimum CGPA of 2.5 in any field from any institution of higher learning recognised by the Government of Malaysia. Candidates with a CGPA lower than 2.5 must have at least 5 years of professional experience; or
- ii. A Diploma in any field from any institution of higher learning recognised by the Government of Malaysia with 10 years of professional experience. Candidates will have to sit for the Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APEL A Certificate APEL T-7) test conducted by the Malaysian Qualification Agency (MQA); or
- iii. Other qualifications equivalent to a bachelor's degree and experience in a related field (business, management, logistics, supply chain, economics or commerce) recognised by the NDUM senate

English language requirement applies foreign/international applicant where English is not their native/official language. This requirement does not apply to International applicants with an accredited bachelor's and master's degree obtained from Malaysian-based academic institutions.
