Entry Requirement

- i. A bachelor's degree with a minimum CGPA of 2.5 in any field from any institution of higher learning recognised by the Government of Malaysia. Candidates with a CGPA lower than 2.5 must have at least 5 years of professional experience; or
- ii. A Diploma in any field from any institution of higher learning recognised by the Government of Malaysia with 10 years of proffesional experience. Candidates will have to sit for Accreditation of Prior Experential Learning (APEL A Certificate APEL T-7) test conducted by Malaysian Qualification Agency (MQA); or
- iii. Other qualifications equivalent to bachelor's degree and experience in a related field (business, management, logistics, supply chain, economics or commerce) recognised by the NDUM senate

The English language requirement is applicable to foreign/international applicant where English is not their native/official language. This requirement not applicable to International applicant with an accredited bachelor and master's degree obtained from Malaysian based academic institutions.
